Most of the members at the centre have multiple conditions. My duties/tasks are;

Achievements/Tasks

- ◊ Building trust, positive behavior and providing emotional support by treating members with compassion, empathy, respect, dignity, politeness and patience. Carrying out research about adults and children living with learning disabilities in different communities as well as publicizing the Centre's outreach projects by distributing flyers and posting pictures on social media. Assisting in income generating projects such as poultry and vegetable gardening projects
- ◊ Following health and safety procedures ensuring patients who are prone to epileptic seizures are in safe environment away from bright lights, loud noises or crowds which may trigger their condition and also ensuring that they always have helmets on them.
- ◊ Attending training workshops and centre meetings to continuously develop new skills like solar behavior approach when dealing with patients with autism spectrum disorder and challenging behavior.
- ◊ Encouraging physical exercises to members of the centre needing physiotherapy as per physiotherapist's instructions as well as doing sports and other outdoor rehabilitation programs like playing soccer, swimming, making balls and mates so as to boost morale.
- ◊ Assisting in drafting and keeping records of all patients care plans and risk assessments and carrying out administrative tasks such as receipting donations, sorting out donations of clothes, accessories and drafting duty rosters of the centre.
- ◊ Helping patients to be as independent as possible by encouraging and monitoring those who can to do house chores such as cooking, washing dishes, laundry and cleaning to ensure that the house is tidy and safe.
- ◊ Planning and preparing meals and adhering to patients' special diets and supplementary drinks under nursing supervision.
- ◊ Observing and reporting patients behavior and other patient information to the nurse as well as handling emergencies so as to optimize treatment planning and care delivery.
- ◊ Lifting patients using appropriate equipment in accordance with moving and handling policy. Transporting members to different functions like doctor's appointments.
